

Rules for the Ranking of Rink-Hockey Players

(updated at 01.07.2025 to consider World Club Champs.)

Remark: This is not an all-time ranking, but just a ranking of players for the 5 years most recent period, taking into account the performance of teams where players participate.

1. This ranking is based uniquely in

- performance of club and national team where players belong;
- classification in major club and national competitions

2. Time of calculation is current year + the 4 precedent years.

3. Players enter the ranking if they obtain one of the following classifications:

- national teams classed up to the 5th place (inclusive) in World Championships during the 5 years period;
- national teams classed up to the 3rd place (inclusive) in European Championships or 2nd place (inclusive) in South American Championships during the 5 years period;
- club teams classed in the 1st place of the World Club Championship, European League, South American Club Championship and Intercontinental Cup during the 5 years period;

4. For each year, the ranking of club teams and the ranking of national teams will be considered as for the 31th December. For the current year, also the ranking of club teams at 30th June will be computed;

5. The rate for each player will be computed in the following manner:

- Average (rate Club/ rate National team, for current year to year - 2) x 2 + average (rate Club/ rate National team, for years -3 and -4)/ 3

- Additional points will be given, to add to the previous average, according to the classifications in major competitions, as follows:

- World Championship: 1st - 50 pts; 2nd - 20; 3rd - 10; 4th - 5; 5th – 3 (+ 20 points for participation)
- European Championship: 1st - 30; 2nd - 12; 3rd - 6; 4th – 2 (+ 15 points for participation)
- PanAmerican Championship: 1st - 30; 2nd - 12; 3rd - 6; 4th – 2 (+ 15 points for participation)
- World Club Championship: 1st – 15; 2nd - 6
- Intercontinental Cup: 1st - 10
- European League: 1st - 10
- South American Club Champ.: 1st - 10
- Nations Cup: 1st - 10; 2nd - 4; 3rd – 2 (+ 10 points for participation)

6. Players no longer active will be eliminated from the list;

7. Ranking is to be published twice a year in rinkhockey.net website.
